- 2. Introductions: Katie Kohler, Chicago Park School Principal.
- 3. <u>Approval of Agenda or Correction of Agenda</u>: *Jo Ann Fites Kaufman moved to approve the Agenda. Second by Linda Miller; Approved 4-0.*
